### [Affiliation Agreements – New upload feature allows schools to view agreements online](#)

In response to user requests, the CCPS team has created a solution that gives provider coordinators the optional feature to upload a copy of an affiliation agreement into CCPS. If the provider site uploads an affiliation agreement, the associated school is also able to view the document on the Affiliation Agreements page.

To view an uploaded Affiliation Agreement:

1. Click **Affiliation Agreements** in the left-side menu
2. Click the **View** button, located in the View column

Note: View button will only display if the provider site has uploaded the affiliation agreement.

## California Community Colleges and Foundation for California Community Colleges First Response Fund

Thousands of California Community College students struggled to stay in school when the COVID-19 pandemic hit. To help keep them enrolled, the California Community Colleges Chancellor’s Office and the Foundation for California Community Colleges worked together to create the First Response Fund, a relief fund that provided emergency cash assistance to nursing students at more than 70 California community colleges. The emergency grants helped students pay for rent, insurance, licensing exams and other urgent costs to help them stay in school so they can finish their degrees and certificates and join the workforce.
